Admission to membership of the club is entirely at the discretion of the committee which may reject application without providing reasons.

The current membership and joining fees (£20 - £10 Joining Fee and £10 membership) are payable upon application and should accompany this form. Should an application be unsuccessful a full refund will be made.

Incomplete or illegible forms cannot be accepted.

New Members Joining

Revised process from August 2018

Forms no longer need to be signed by committee members to be handed out.



A potential new member who has two current members who know and are prepared to nominate them will use the same process as before.

Those people are vouching for their good character, and if they are prepared to do so then they would propose and second as before. To propose and second however should require reasonable knowledge of the person: the proposer and seconder should actually KNOW them, not just have been introduced or seen them once or twice.

If someone asks to join who is NOT known to current members however, then they should be asked to sign in as a visitor.

Any full member can sign a person in as a visitor, including staff who are full members and committee members. People should not be signed in more than once a month according to the current rules. Any visitor who behaves unacceptably during their visit should be noted, refused entry in future, and refused membership.

Any visitor who has been signed in two times in the past three months without problem is then eligible to join: two Committee members / Officers must simply confirm on the form they have checked the visitors book and confirmed they had been signed in two times in the three months prior to the dated membership application and that there was no record of unacceptable behaviour. Those Committee members are being asked to verify: that the person has followed the rules, been signed into the book (at least twice) in three months, no-one has complained about their time in the club, and is signing that they have checked that - acting as proposer and seconder, but not claiming to know the person personally.

Completed forms and payments should be taken as before, and then go through the same process of being on the board until the next Committee meeting as before.
